Dear Brothers & Sisters in Christ,

This month of April is split evenly between the final weeks of Lent, and the jubilant days of Pascha. It is a month of half fast, half feast. Thus it is a perfect sample of what the Orthodox Christian life is always about.

There are two extreme tendencies

among modern Christians regarding the spiritual life that are both a distortion of our faith. The first sees the world as entirely doomed. In this paradigm, life is seen as tedious or dismal. Everyday is like a strict fast, where self-denial becomes a disdain for the world God has created. Of course, there have been hermits who have left the world to face

their passions and be healed. But they did so precisely so that they could become vessels of sorrowful joy as they prayed for all mankind.

The other extreme is to think that Christians are supposed to be happy and exuberant all the time. For them, the solemn days of fasting and the important work of self-denial are thought to contradict the Gospel and the proclamation of the heavenly kingdom. Yet they fail to see that we Christians still struggle with temptation and demonic deception. We still wrestle with our "old man," and therefore

must take seriously what the Church teaches us about moderation and sobriety.

The middle way between these two poles is perfectly expressed in our Orthodox calendar. We are given periods of fasting, solemn days to focus on repentance in order to recognize our own sins and the captivity of the world. By limiting ourselves and increasing the rigor of our prayer we strive for forgiveness and seek to

acquire divine humility. But

we are also given periods of feasting: a time to rejoice in God's blessings, a time to celebrate the gift of salvation he offers us. Through the feast we are able to experience what life is like when God conquers sin and proclaims his creation to be "good" once more.

Fasting and feasting, sorrow and joy—this is the way of a Christian. Our calendar prepares us to engage the present world as it actually is, not as we want it to be. And now that we are concluding the somber days of Lent, let us prepare for the glorious appearing of the risen Bridegroom who invites us to his recline at his eternal banquet.
