Dear Brothers & Sisters in Christ,

Every summer, Orthodox Christians from across North America and around the world gather in a remote part of Alaska for a pilgrimage to the places St. Herman once inhabited: Kodiak and Spruce Islands. This event is coordinated in conjunction with the feast of his canonization on August 9 (an especially good time of year to travel to the far north).

George Fr. Gladky, the founding pastor of our Cathedral, was present at this event in 1970, just as newly-emancipated the Orthodox Church in America conducted glorification service for St. Herman; and he brought back a relic of St. Herman that would later be placed in the shrine located on the right side of our temple. He was so impressed by what he experienced during his

trip that he dubbed the property in Miami Lakes (purchased in the 8o's to relocate the Cathedral) as "New Kodiak."

Our parish, and the entire OCA, is deeply connected with that initial mission of 1794 that included St. Herman. Although Orthodoxy in this land would later be characterized as a diaspora phenomenon—due to the many thousands of immigrants who arrived from Central and Eastern Europe, the Balkans, and the Middle East in the late 19th and early 20th centuries—it is important to remember how it all started. A vision was set forth:

to evangelize the New World.

Generations of Orthodox Christians have been assimilated into American culture, which in turn has been slowly pushing the OCA towards a truly indigenous reality. But additional waves of immigration have continued to arrive in America; and with these new arrivals comes new connections and understandings of Orthodox Christianity. But the old saying, "What is good for the goose is good for the gander," does not necessarily apply in this

case. Stories of how things are done

in countries that are majority Orthodox, and that have very different cultures, may not be helpful in our context. We need to practice discernment in this case.

According to the Scriptures, our duty is not to make others the same culture and ethnicity as we are, but to assist them in becoming faithful members of the Body of Christ. At the same time, it would also be the acme of foolishness to artificially fashion an "American Orthodoxy." We should neither be

constrained by whatever is going on "over there," nor be driven by what we wish to concoct over here.

If we emphasize secondary matters over "the one thing needful" (Lk 10:42), we will certainly be judged for this on the last day. Rather, we need to put aside all earthly cares and focus on the mission at hand. If we live faithfully, time will do the rest.
